Certificate of Authenticity



I certify that the Violin submitted to me, in my opinion is an Italian instrument, original in all its major parts, made by Costantino Celani in Ascoli Piceno c1920-30. It bears a Pareschi label.

Description: The two-piece back of quarter-cut maple with irregular medium width flames slightly descending from the centre joint; the ribs and scroll of similar stock to that of the back; the table in two pieces of spruce with narrow grain at the centre joint, opening out to medium grain towards the flanks; the varnish of a deep orange-yellow colour over a light brown ground.

This Violin is a typical example of the maker's work, currently in excellent condition and measures 35.4cm in length of back with widths of 16.8, 10.8 and 20.7cm.
