*We certify that the violin, illustrated on the reverse side of this document, was made, in our judgement, by Antonino Graziano in Palermo as indicated by the original label it bears dated 4 April 1985, with his signature below the date. The instrument is branded internally on the neck block with his name and a second brand-stamp, SV within a circle, which indicates his origin in the town of San Vito Lo Capo in the Province of Trapani.*

*Description:*

*The back consists of two pieces of figured maple, the bass side cut on the quarter with the treble side slightly off the quarter, displaying a flame pattern of medium width that descends from the center joint. The ribs and scroll are of maple similar to that of the back. The belly is of two symmetric pieces of spruce with an annual ring pattern of a narrow width at the center joint that gradually broadens towards the flanks. The varnish is of a brownish golden-orange color. This violin is a characteristic example of the work of Antonino Graziano for the period.*
